Regular Courses



English Programme for Adults

Beginner, Elementary, Pre-Intermediate, Intermediate & Advanced.

Register and take a placement test to estimate your English level.

Learn vital grammar and vocabulary and develop your speaking, pronunciation, listening, reading and writing skills.

Each class has a maximum of 12 students.

Minimum of 5 students required to start a class.

English Programme for Young Learners

Class 1: for children aged 5-9 Class 2: for children aged 10-12

When the child is confident and proficient in English they have an early added advantage at school. This helps them get ahead in education and also in future career opportunities.

At WLC, the teachers encourage learning through talk, play, songs and natural interaction, in a safe, secure and happy environment.

The child can be prepared for the Cambridge Movers, Shakers and Flyers Exams. Each class has a maximum of 12 students.

Enrolment Dates

Students who are interested to study at WLC are required to fill up the Application Form with Registration Fee. An interview and placement test will be arranged with the Principal/teacher to determine a suitable level prior to the commencement of classes. You will receive a letter of offer with the enrolment date, time of first class and class schedule.

Continuity of Enrolment

The duration of the programme will be stated in the letter of offer. A regular course programme consist of 20 lessons of 1 hour each.

Enrolment of a current student will be terminated if:

- The student notifies of his/her wish to terminate their enrolment with one month's notice.
- WLC terminates the students' enrolment or suspends or excludes the student in accordance with the provisions of WLC Policies.
- The student has completed all course requirements.

Refusal and Cancellation of Enrolment

WLC may cancel an enrolment, refuse to enrol or refuse to re-enrol a student for the following reasons:

- Misconduct.
- Failure to arrive on the commencement date.
- The student has gained admission by misrepresentation, falsification of documents or other fraudulent means.
- Non-payment of tuition fees.
- Cancellation of a student visa.
- Other reasons as deemed by WLC.

Refund of Fees

No refunds of tuition fees are given except in the event a foreign student's application of visa or permission to study has been rejected by MOE or Immigration.

Attendance

The attendance of all students enrolled at WLC is monitored closely to ensure that everyone in class is following the whole course and able to maximise their opportunities for success. An attendance is taken at each lesson by the teacher.

Code of Conduct

All students, staff, facilitators and visitors are expected to behave in a considerate and courteous manner. WLC aims to provide a quality education in which all students are encouraged to strive for excellence and fulfil their potential. Please speak in English inside the school and on WLC organised trips at all times. Mobile phones, tablets and any other electronic devices must be turned off during class time.

Unacceptable Conduct

Unacceptable behaviour includes but is not limited to:

- Unauthorised use of WLC intellectual property including name, logo, manuals, materials, trademarks, designs, confidential information and copyright material.
- Viewing or distributing offensive material via Internet, e-mail or other means.
- Discrimination, harassment and victimisation.
- Bullying and intimidation.
- Making racist or sexist comments.
- Assaulting or attempting to assault anyone while on WLC premises.
- Inappropriate possession of guns, knives or other weapons which engaging in WLC activities.


